1) Check the quality of your Child Protection training

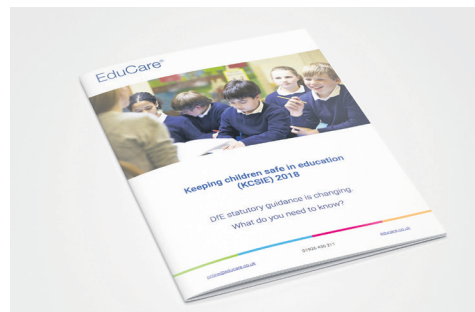
To remain compliant with inspectors, you must closely examine the content of all training and ensure it reflects the Keeping Children Safe In Education (KCSIE) 2018 update.

2) Review your Safeguarding policies

Inspectors are expected to ask to see school policies relating to the updated guidance from the start of the new academic year.

3) Check staff understand Contextual Safeguarding and Peer-on-Peer Abuse

The key theme of the changes in KCSIE is



peer-on-peer abuse. Whilst this safeguarding issue is nothing new, the introduction of the new Part 5 on child-on-child sexual violence and sexual harassment shows the importance the DfE are placing on it.

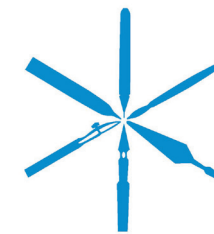
