WHEN TEXTILE ARTIST Gudrun Sjödén established her self-named clothing line back in the 1970s, she had a very clear long-term vision for her brand: colourful, functional clothes that would last and be accessible to women of all sizes, shapes and ages.

She also wanted the brand to be an inspiration and advocate for environmental change - both big and small. Her Scandiinspired timeless cuts and lively prints are now worn throughout the seasons by women all around the world, and the brand promotes green change for the better. Each year a deserving project is chosen to be supported. Often these are linked to the environment, such as the development of sustainable cotton farming in Gujarat, India, or a local Sussex based honey bee research program.

Over the decades, Gudrun Sjödén has nurtured a good relationship with its manufacturers in order to develop sustainable production. This has resulted in organic jersey from Greece and organic cotton grown by certified Fairtrade farmers in India, which is spun and then dyed without the use of chemicals. Natural materials such as recycled wool and silk, as well as plant-based fibres like lyocell and modal, are chosen for their low impact on the environment. The brand has also created its own green labelling system, making



it easy for customers to let sustainability be a deciding factor when shopping.

The environment itself is a continuing source of design inspiration as the upcoming autumn collection is influenced by the ever life-giving forest and its palette of muted and vibrant tones.
